

Purpose of SIC

Mandated by law, the School Improvement Council (SIC) serves as an advisory group to the school. The SIC brings together parents, school faculty, and community stakeholders to work together to collectively establish, monitor, and evaluate specific long and short range goals for student achievement. In addition, the SIC is a resource for parents, community members, and faculty members to share ideas and concerns about the school. Other functions of the SIC are to provide an annual school report to parents and the community and increase parental awareness and involvement of SIC initiatives.

2020-2021 GOALS

- 1) By 2023-2024 the percentage of stakeholders who report “Students behave well in their hallways, in the lunchroom, and on school grounds” will increase by 25% for teachers, 25% for students, and 25% for parents as measured by the School Climate Survey data.
- 2) By 2023-2024, the percentage of students scoring Met or Exemplary on the SC READY ELA assessment will increase by 25%, and the percentage of students scoring Met or Exemplary on the SC READY Math assessment will increase by 25%
