The vision of Northside Elementary School of the Arts is to be an academic and arts community that inspires creativity, courage and character.

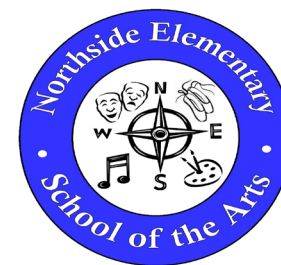

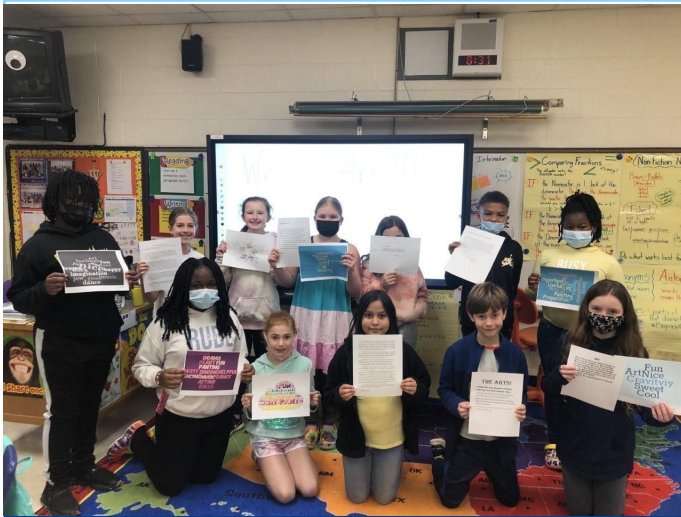
