SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS

This year due to the pandemic, the year look much different. Student achievement from the ending of 2019-20 was not administered. Students were out of school beginning March 16, 2020 therefore, a loss of learning occurred.

Richmond Drive Elementary officially kicked off the school year on August 26, 2020 with family orientation. Close to 100% of families participated in the orientation sessions with teachers.

MAP testing was completed early in the year. Data showed students in first through fifth grades had deficits in both reading and math.

Coaches from our district level and school level worked closely with teachers to enhance learning by focusing primarily on reading and math.

Fall to Winter MAP data showed significant gains in many areas by students in first through fifth grades.
