SCHOOL ACHIEVEMENTS

Richmond Drive Elementary School started the year in July with an outdoor event to celebrate students as well as the new students joining us. The event was sponsored by Cordarrelle Patterson, former student and NFL player.

The week before school started the school hosted an Open House / Meet the Teacher time. Close to seventy-five percent of families joined us. This was a great opportunity to begin building relationships with families and students.

MAP testing was completed early in the year. Data showed students in first through fifth grades had deficits in both reading and math.

Coaches from our district level and school level worked closely with teachers to enhance learning by focusing primarily on reading and math.

Fall to Winter MAP data showed significant gains in many areas by students in first through fifth grades. Support was continued by the math and reading coach staff.

More growth was noted in MAP testing for both reading and math as seen in those who had completed the assessment.
