Our enrollment numbers this year have been steady, and we anticipate an increase in student enrollment in the 2018-2019 school year.

Sunset Park has earned five South Carolina Palmetto Gold and Silver Awards for the academic performance of its students! We had one student earn a perfect score on the SCPASS science test this year. Additionally, we had thirty-seven students who qualified as Duke TIP scholars this year. Our students continue to make us so proud!

Our school staff has collaborated this year on many school-wide goals. Planning sessions are led by our G/T teacher-coach, our Literacy Specialist, and District Math and Literacy Coaches. We are also in partnership with the College of Education at Winthrop University.
