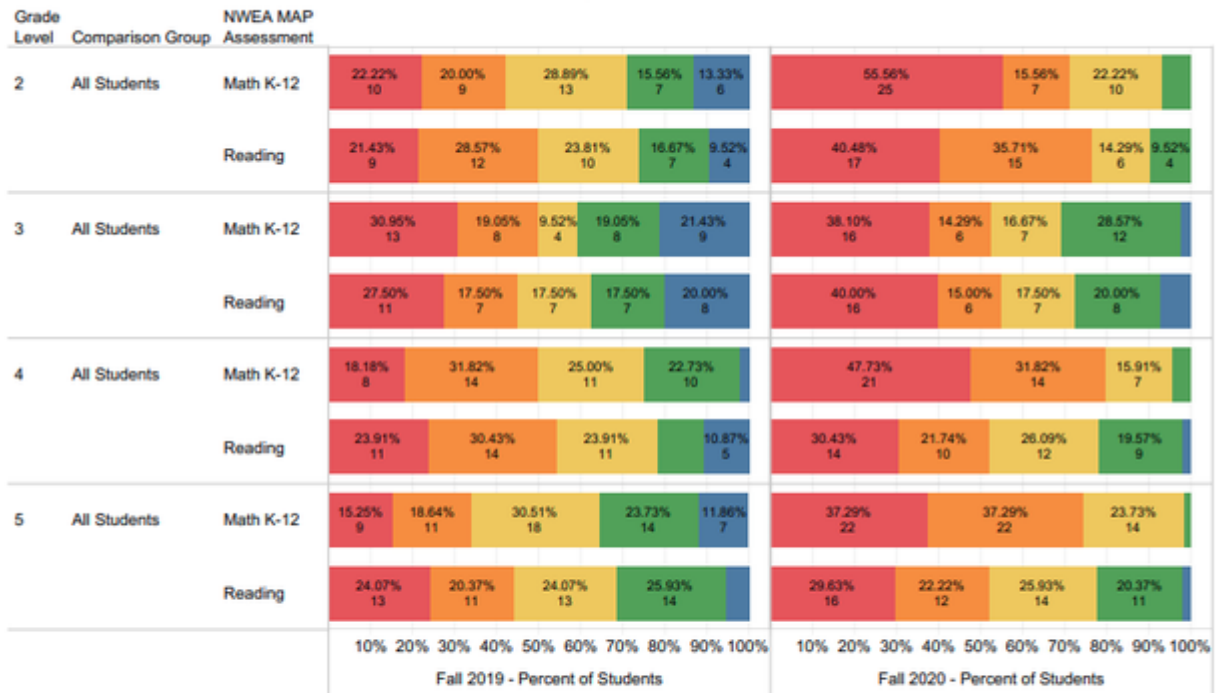

We had lots more children that have fallen below grade level in both reading and math due to school closures.

School Closures

On March 16, 2020, our schools closed due to Covid-19 pandemic. We moved quickly to online teaching for 3-5 and sending packets of work home for k-2.

We missed our students and were so glad that over 60% of our students came back on an A-B rotation in August. About 29% of our students are still virtually through the Rock Hill Virtual Academy. We look forward to the day that we can have school 5 days a week with all students.

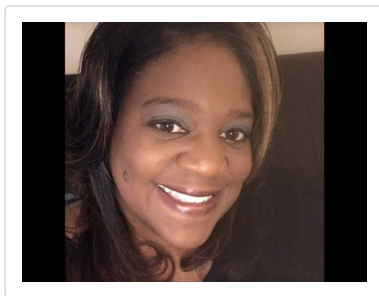
A Little about School Improvement Council

A School Improvement Council (SIC) is an advisory body to the principal and school. State law requires that every K- 12 public school have an SIC that includes:

- At least two parents elected by parents.
- At least two teachers elected by teachers.
- Community members who do not have children enrolled at the school, appointed by the principal.
- The principal and other ex-officio members.

Needs identified by our SIC this year

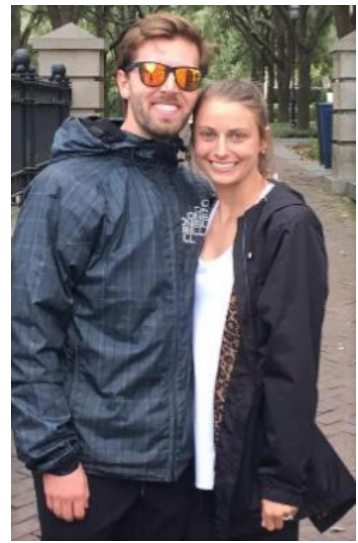
- Addressing the Covid Slide in Math and Reading

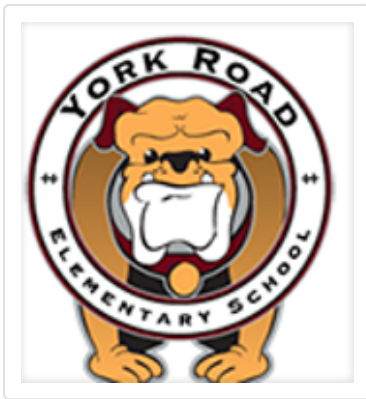
