SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS

One of the goals identified by the School Improvement Council was to increase achievement by 9 points in Science for the 2012-2013 school year. Teachers have risen to the challenge and have provided the following Science enrichment activities:

- I2 Science Club for all students that met monthly for exciting science application.
- Science Fair school-wide with 30 + participants.
- Science Bowl Team that placed 2nd in the RHSD #3 District competition!
- Programming from the Carolina Raptor Center, Camp Cherokee and more.

Other SIC goals included:

English/Language Arts: Increasing scores by 5 points for all students and

decreasing the amount of interventions needed.

Math: Decreasing the number of students needing Tier 3 intervention or referred for evaluation by 10 percent.

TITLE I

With a large free/reduced lunch population, our school is categorized as a Title 1 School. Because of this, our school receives significant extra funding from the State of SC for programs that benefit every child. This year, our Title 1 monies have been used for a full day 4 year old Kindergarten, 2 Literacy Coaches, 2 Instructional Assistants, Parent/ Student Math & Literacy Nights, and other various resources.

Our teachers are dedicated to keeping our students learning throughout the summer. Last summer IDES provided "You've Got Mail" and "Reading Rocks" as summer enrichment reading programs.
