## OPES GOALS

- By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, OPES will increase the percentage of parents that state they are contacted by the school for positive comments/communication by 20% based on Parent Climate Survey. (2017-2018 Baseline: 60%)
- By the end of the 2023-2024 school year, teachers will show learn and implement personalized learning strategies which will result in a 10-point increase in the percentage of students at OPES who respond "Mostly Agree" and "Agree" on the SC Department of Education Student Climate Survey statement, "I am satisfied with the learning environment in my school." (2018-2019 Baseline: 78.7%)
- By the Spring of the 2023-2024 school year, the percentage of students in grades 3-5 scoring above the 66th percentile on the Math MAP assessment will increase by 15%. (2017-2018 Baseline: 31.8%)

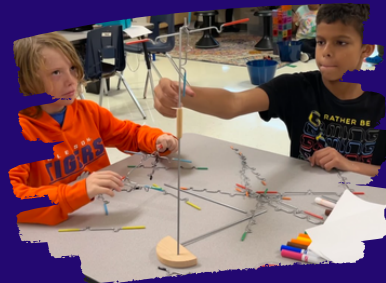
