OPES GOALS

- By 2029, at Old Pointe Elementary School, 80% of 3rd grade; 80% of 4th grade; and 80% of 5th grade students will score MEETS or EXCEEDS in Math as measured by the SC Ready State Assessment from the baseline data of 3rd grade at 53.7%; 4th grade at 43.8%; 5th grade at 36.4% in 2023.
- By 2029, at Old Pointe Elementary School, 85% of 3rd grade; 85% of 4th grade; and 85% of 5th grade students will score MEETS or EXCEEDS in ELA as measured by the SC Ready State Assessment from the baseline data of 3rd grade at 53.7%; 4th grade at 62.9%; 5th grade at 60% in 2023.
- By 2029, Old Pointe Elementary School will work to decrease DISAGREES to 10.4% on the Climate Survey for Elementary-Middle School Students' Perception of SOCIAL PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT from a baseline on the 2023 Survey of 25.4% DISAGREE.
