POINTES OF PRIDE

- South Pointe High School implemented its five innovative STEAM Pathways in Computer Science, Engineering, Health Science, Clean Energy, and Media Convergence during the 2020-2021. Over 202 students completed coursework in the STEAM Pathways.
- The Governor's School of Science and Math (GSSM) at South Pointe High School, which offers up to 49 dual credits in math, science, and engineering, is in its fourth year. SPHS GSSM is one of 18 elite schools in SC and graduated its first GSSM class. Students had a combined cumulative GPA of 4.9.
- South Pointe Student Council collected 2, 590 items, adopted 57 kids in Foster Care, and students earned 548 community service hours for the 2020 Wishes for Winter community event. In addition to excellence community service, South Pointe's Student Council received the Gold Honor Council Award, Dr. Conner was named SCASC Administrator of the Year, and senior student Katia George was inducted into the SCASC Terry McCoy Leadership Hall of Fame.
- South Pointe Robotics team finished 4th in the SC Robotics Competition and 3rd place in the Robotics Motivate Award.
- South Pointe Beta Club, Recycling Club, Student Council, Progeny, SADD, PEARLS, and Air Force ROTC participated in many community service projects, including voter registration drives, campus beautification, detention home donations, Youth Service Day, RHSD Teacher Recruitment Fair, and blood drives. They collectively donated over 6,000 hours of community service and activities throughout the year.

2020-2021 athletic accomplishments:

- 50 scholar-athletes made their All-Region teams and six were named to All-State teams.
- 4 Teams won Region Championships.
- Boys Basketball Team won the 4A State Championship
- 1 Individual Wrestling State Champion.
- 2 Region Coaches of the Year.
- 12 teams competed participated in the State Playoffs.
- 13 student-athletes signed letters of intent to play at

In the Arts...

- The Band of Thunder made its 13th straight State Finals with Superior rating, finishing 5 th at Upper State and 9 th in the state. At the individual level, the band had five students selected as a region band member. All other band competitions were canceled due to COVID-19.
- The South Pointe Chorus had a superb year while participating in many local and state events and activities. Two students were invited to the highly selective South Carolina All-State Honor Choir.
- Senior Art student Dasani Jackson was one of five York County high school artists chosen to have her artwork enlarged and displayed on White Street as part of the Arts Council of York County's public art display.
- This year, South Pointe students competed in the Blumey Awards, in which the best actor and best actress from each school were chosen by a panel of judges, and those students went on to compete against others from the participating high schools in the entire greater Charlotte region. From that competition, the top six finalists were named, including our own Molly Neal; the overall winner will then go on to compete in the National Jimmy Awards for High School Musical Theatre.

- 15.49% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2020 Algebra 1 EOC.
- 30.33% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2020 Biology 1 EOC.
- 80.53% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2020 English II EOC.
- The Spring 2021 average score for students completing the SAT was 971.
- The average score 2020-2021 for students completing the 2020-2021 ACT was 16.9.
