"POINTES" OF PRIDE

- South Pointe High School continued its five innovative STEAM Pathways in Computer Science, Engineering, Health Science, Clean Energy, and Media Convergence during the 2021-2022.
- The Governor's School of Science and Math (GSSM) at South Pointe High School, which offers up to 49 dual credits in math, science, and engineering, is in its fourth year. SPHS GSSM is one of 18 elite schools in SC and graduated students with an avg GPA of 4.65 in its 21-22 GSSM class. One student won the Excellence in Engineering Award.
- South Pointe STEAM & Beta Club students volunteered at the RHSchools First Annual Science Festival this year. Beta students also participated in a litter cleanup as part of YC's Polar Bear litter pickup.
- South Pointe Robotics team went to the State Semi-Finals. 1st place State Champions-Design Award, 2nd place State Champions -Compass Award and 3rd place overall in the SC Robotics Competition.
- South Pointe National Honor Society, Student Council, PEARLS, and Air Force ROTC participated in many community service projects, including YC book drive, Toys for Happiness, Come See Me Festival, homeless baby item donations, RHSD bus driver donations and Wishes for Winter. They collectively donated over 6,000 hours of community service and activities throughout the year.

2021-2022 athletic accomplishments:

- 35 scholar-athletes made their All-Region teams and four were named to All-State teams.
- 3 Teams won Region Championships.
- Football Team won the 4A State Championship making it our 7th in 17 years while pushing our record to 183-36 overall
- 1 Individual Track State Champion.
- 1 Region Coaches of the Year.
- 13 teams competed participated in the State Playoffs.
- 25 student-athletes signed letters of intent to play in college
- 68 Senior Student Athletes maintained a 3.5 GPA or higher throughout their high school career.

In the Arts...

The Band of Thunder had a great season performing their show "Run Free." The band won first place in class and all caption awards at both the Olde English Festival of Bands and the Chesnee Eagle Classic. The band competed in 4A for the first time ever at the SCBDA upper state and finished 6th place and advanced on to the State for the 14th consecutive year finishing 10th with a Superior rating. The symphonic band earned a Superior with Distinction in grade 4 which is the highest possible rating. The band had three students make region band. SPHS Theatre students received the following accolades: 2 South Carolina Theatre Association (SCTA) all-star cast awards, 6 SCTA 6th place recognition for one act play, 3 Palmetto Dramatic Association Play Festival and SC Thespian Competition (PDA/ITS) Superior ratings in solo musical. Three SPHS seniors were selected to exhibit in a southeastern regional juried art show that featured high school to professional level artists. The exhibit was also published in a catalog! To top things off, Lucy Cassidy's "Magnolia Quilt" sculpture placed third in the show! SPHS also swept the county-wide k-12 Youth Art Month show, winning 6 awards- 1/3 of the awards given!

STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

- 35% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2021 Algebra 1 EOC.
- 49% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2021 Biology 1 EOC.
- 71% Pass Rate for students making a C or Higher on the Fall 2021 English II EOC.
- The Spring 2022 average score for students completing the SAT was 969.
- The average score 2020-2021 for students completing the 2021-2022 ACT was 16.1.
