

## Student Achievement Data – 2021

- The 2021 Senior Class earned \$4,016,619 in scholarship offerings.
- Six students were named South Carolina Palmetto Fellows for a total of \$175,200 to attend college in South Carolina. Eligibility requirements include at least a 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, a 3.5 cumulative GPA, and a top six percent ranking.
- Thirty-eight students were recipients of the South Carolina Four-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$760,000.
- Fifty-two students were recipients of the South Carolina Two-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$520,000.
- Forty-two students were recipients of the South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Scholarship for a total of \$191,520.
- Local scholarships totaled \$22,690.
- Thirty-four students were Honor Graduates.
- The 2021 On-Time Graduation Rate was 85.4%, while the state average was 83.3%.
- The 2021 College and Career Readiness Metric was 70.1%, while the state average was 61.1%.
- The 2021 Advanced Placement Human Geography Success Rate was 77.8%, while the state rate was 56.0%.

- Three football players were selected as AA All State.
- One faculty member was selected as the head coach and one faculty member was selected as the assistant coach of the Border Bowl Football Game.

### Student Achievement

By the end of the 2026-2027 academic year, the achievement gap between our school and the state will decrease to 7.5 percentage points in Algebra 1, Biology 1, and English 2.

### Teacher/Administrator Quality

By the end of the 2026-2027 academic year, the retention rate and professional growth of both certified and classified staff will increase annually according to the follow data sources: certified teacher status, teacher effectiveness rate, teacher retention rate, teacher attendance rate, & staff retention rate.

### School Climate

By the end of the 2026-2027 academic year, the percentage of BHS students, parents, and teachers satisfied with the learning environment, physical environment, and school-home relations will increase to at least 86.5%.
