## Student Achievement Data – 2020

- The 2020 Senior Class earned \$4,089,224 in scholarship offerings.
- Four students were named South Carolina Palmetto Fellows for a total of \$116,800 to attend college in South Carolina. Eligibility requirements include at least a 1200 on the SAT or 27 on the ACT, a 3.5 cumulative GPA, and a top six percent ranking.
- Thirty-six students were recipients of the South Carolina Four-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$720,000.
- Forty-nine students were recipients of the South Carolina Two-Year Life Scholarship for a total of \$490,000.
- Forty-two students were recipients of the South Carolina Lottery Tuition Assistance Scholarship for a total of \$191,520.
- Local scholarships totaled \$22,300.
- Thirty-two students were Honor Graduates.
- The 2020 On-Time Graduation Rate was 84.4%, while the state average was 82.2%.
- The 2020 Advanced Placement Human Geography Success Rate was 71.4%, while the state rate was 59.9%.
- The percentage of teachers returning to BHS was 92.7%.
