- ♦ 2024 SCReady ELA - 63.4% of 3rd graders scored approaches or higher
- ♦ 2024 SCReady Math - 69.5% of 3rd graders scored approaches or higher
- ♦ 2024 iReady Reading Assessments indicate 54% of kindergarten through third graders were reading on level.
- ♦ 2024 iReady Math Assessments indicate an average of 38% of 5K through third graders were on grade level for math.



School Happenings

- > We began the 2024-2025 school year with the theme "Game On: Level Up" We incorporated this theme school-wide to celebrate student success in various ways throughout the school year as students "leveled up" on iReady, reading levels, or reached behavior goals..
- > All students were provided school supplies and an opportunity to meet their teacher during a Back-to-School Meet & Greet.
- > Classroom student awards programs were held to recognize academic success, academic improvement, perfect attendance, and character education/citizenship of our students. Also, students were recognized on social media and our school website.
- > Community engagement events such as Family Nights and school programs were held. Grandparents' Game Night was a tremendous success!
- > Our school facility received the following upgrades: new auditorium flooring and seating, additions to our playground areas, new digital sign, updated windows, air conditioning added to the gymnasium and fresh paint on the school's interior.
- > Ms. Lameisha Peebles was recognized by the BPS staff as our Teacher of the Year and Mr. William Buckmon was recognized as our BPS Staff Person of the Year.

School Partners

- > Barnwell Primary School is constantly striving to create a high performing positive school culture for all stakeholders.
- > We are in partnership with the Save the Children Foundation to provide reading intervention for 100 students. This program provides daily reading intervention for students in kindergarten through third grade.
- > A 21st Century Community Learning Center Grant, which is led by the D.I.G. Organization supports an after-school program at BPS.
- > Our school is proud to offer a Montessori program for students. We work with the South Carolina Montessori Alliance to maintain the integrity of our program. Currently we have three classes serving students ages 3-5 years of age. We also have a combination 1st/2nd grade class that serves students.
- > The Original Six Foundation partnered with Barnwell Primary School to provide our students with an excellent online program known as Kids A-Z (RAZ-Kids). This program provides each classroom with hundreds of e-books and quizzes that each student may read or listen to for pleasure or assigned reading at school or home. Also, the foundation sponsors My First Library, which provides books to each kindergarten student for their home library.
- > Our school garden continues to grow thanks to the many grants written by Mrs. Coble and generous donations from our local community. Thanks to DonorsChoose, the SC Children's Fund, Old Barnwell, Humble Acres Organics, Green Tech Green Houses, Tractor Supply, Barnwell Walmart, Veggie Cupboard Community Garden and Barnwell County Water Conservation supporting this endeavor.

SIC Annual Goals

- By the end of the 2029-2030 school year, the percentage of our students, parents, and teacher satisfied with the learning environment, social/physical environment, and home-school relations will increase annually (each surveyed area is averaged, then student, parent, and teacher averages are combined).
- By the end of the 2029-2030 academic school year, the retention rate and professional growth of both certified and classified staff will increase annually according to the following data points: Percentage of classrooms led by certified teachers, teacher effectiveness rate, teacher retention rate, staff retention rate, and staff satisfaction percentage.
- By the end of the 2029-2030 school year, the school will demonstrate an annual increase in the percentage of students performing at or above state averages as defined by the following data-points: SC Ready ELA and Math (3rd Grade only) and iReady Diagnostic Assessment results (5K-3rd Grade).
