School Happenings

- > Due to COVID-19, quarterly student award programs were held during the school year within each classroom to recognize academic success, academic improvement, perfect attendance, and character education/citizenship of our students. Also, students are recognized on social media and our school website.
- > The Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) program continued to reduce the number of office referrals through more positive approaches to discipline. Students received rewards at the Mighty Mustang Mall throughout the year for good behavior and attendance.
- > BES held LEAP Week (Learn, Evaluate, Analyze, and Prepare) in August to provide information to our students about preparing for COVID procedures during the year. Students also participated in Math and ELA enrichment activities.
- > Two bookfairs were held during the year to promote reading at home.
- > BES held a Literacy Night Event in April where all students were provided with reading and writing materials to enhance ELA skills by completing activities at home



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Enhancing the Curriculum

- > Barnwell Elementary has established processes and procedures for monitoring classroom instruction beyond the required statewide 4.0 SC Rubric evaluation system, to ensure continuous improvement in teaching and learning.
- > Teachers utilize Fountas & Pinnell, iStation, and common assessments to plan for differentiated instruction to meet student needs.
- > Three reading and one math interventionist provide extra assistance for struggling students.
- > Reading incentives were held throughout the year to encourage reading for enjoyment.
- > We have a 1-to-1 digital learning environment for all students. Students utilize Chromebooks. All classrooms have Promethean Boards.
- > We support our literacy efforts by providing class sets of books, classroom libraries with leveled readers, and nonfiction reading materials to all of our classrooms.

Community Involvement

- > Barnwell Elementary School is constantly striving to create a high performing positive school culture for all stakeholders. Our theme for the 2020-2021 school year was Leaders in Excellence: Stronger Together.
- > We participated in community service projects such as can food drives and toy drives for needy families. BES collected over 3,000 can goods to support our local food bank during the month of November.
