
Students have the opportunity to earn Blaze Bucks by demonstrating one of the four character traits CSE wishes to instill in each of our students: **Pride**, **Respect**,

Responsibility, and Trustworthiness.



SCHOOL REPORT CARD



For the 2022-2023 school year, Carolina Springs Elementary earned the rating of "**Good**", up from the "Average" rating earned the previous year and only two points away from a rating of "Excellent".



Over the last two years, CSE has progressed tremendously on the SC Ready standardized test issued to all students in grades 3-5. This progress has led Lexington School District One to designate Carolina Springs Elementary as a "School on the Move".

CSE IS A PROUD TITLE ONE SCHOOL

Through Title One Funding, we have been able to not only provide all school supplies for students for the past two years, but have also hosted a "Sponsored Book Fair" where every student in our school has been able to select two books of their choosing at no cost to them. The funding received also allows us to have a full time mathematics instructional coach and certified interventionist on staff. "Knee High Huskies", a 14-week program for 3 and 4 year old children and their parents who are not currently enrolled in a Lexington One preschool program is also offered twice a year at no cost to the families.

Since the 2021-2022 school year, Carolina Springs has maintained a successful archery program. Under the direction of Ms. Haley Hite, fourth and fifth graders have the opportunity to compete in both Bullseye and IBO tournaments.

With nine top three finishes, and a remarkable fourth place showing at the State competition, CSE's archery team will be headed to Nationals in May for the third year in a row.
