## **Our History**

Lady's Island Intermediate and Middle School is tucked away in a natural setting shaded by huge live oaks, pine trees, and is bordered by marshland. In the past three years, we have been the recipient of two Palmetto Silver Awards for Achievement and Closing the Achievement Gap. Our school was remodeled and refitted with high-tech Promethean boards and state-of-the-art science equipment, and in 2009 Lady's Island Middle split into two schools with intermediate grades (5th and 6th) and middle grades (7th and 8th). This year we will be transforming back to a traditional middle school. During the summer of 2011, we added an additional computer lab for Keyboarding instruction, new bleachers for the gymnasium, new tables, redesigned the cafeteria, and new retractable screen, sound system and mounted multi-media projector for the Lecture Theater. In 2014 an electronic scoreboard was installed on the football field and a new field house to include concessions and restrooms is currently being built.
