#### **Our School History**

East North Street Elementary opened its doors in 1956 in the midst of the best neighborhood in Greenville. It was built to provide relief for Laurel School where most of the students living in this area were being bussed. In the fall of 1997, East North Street Elementary established "Academy" identity as a mathematics and science magnet to address issues of declining enrollment and achievement. The magnet enrollment in 1997 at our school started with 17 students. Magnet enrollment today totals 152 students.

In August of 2001, East North Street Academy moved into a new 105,000 square foot facility on 24 acres. The building is wired for the latest advancements in technology.
