



## SIC Goals for 2024-2025

- By 2028, 85% of C.A. Johnson High School students will graduate within four (4) years.
- By 2028, C.A. Johnson High School will retain 88% of teachers through increasing collective efficacy and supporting social/emotional wellness.
- By 2028, C.A. Johnson High School will promote positive school culture through decreasing the number of students impacted by exclusionary disciplinary policies by 20%.

## CAJHS Progress

- CAJHS has been making steady progress towards its goals. This year the school was removed from the Comprehensive School and Improvement (CSI) designation list.
- Chronic absenteeism is down by 6% and suspensions are down by over 120 days.
- The school increased its report card overall score by 5 points, its graduation rate by 6% (up to 74%), all EOC scores increased, and the number of CTE completers have increased from 17 to 55.
