Information on PASS

The State of SC requires students in grades 3-8 to take the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS) each spring. PASS is aligned to the SC Curriculum Standards and includes tests in Writing, ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies. Students receive a score of not met, met, or exemplary on each subject. Please see the score descriptors below:

Exemplary - The student demonstrated exemplary performance in meeting the grade level standard.

Met – The student met the grade level standard.

Not Met – The student did not meet grade level standard.

PASS was first administered to MPA students in Spring, 2009. Results show that we continue to be among the highest performing schools in South Carolina.
