ACADEMICS As we prepare our students to be today's learners, tomorrow's leaders, we continuously provide effective, quality instruction in a safe learning environment so that all students will be college and career ready, lifelong learners and productive citizens.

The following initiatives are utilized: Dual Credit Courses at Technical College of the Low Country (TCL), Honor Roll Recognition, Advanced Placement (AP) classes, four by four block schedule, Parent Nights, Credit Recovery, ACT and EOCT After School Tutorial, AVID elective, and Educational Talent Search through TCL.

2018 Graduating Class received over \$3.9 million in scholarships. 2 Palmetto Fellow Scholars. 41 students qualified for the LIFE Scholarship. 15 students qualified for the Hope Scholarship. 11 Teacher Cadets. 20 ACE Completer Programs Certificates and 13 RHHS CATE Completer Certificates. Additionally, 5 students participated in Dual Enrollment.
