RSAE Middle School Performance Goals by 2025-2026

- The percentage of students in grades 6 8 scoring meets or exceeds in ELA will increase (6%, 7%) annually as measured by the state's English assessment.
- The percentage of students in grades 6 8 scoring meets or exceeds in math will increase (5%, 6%) annually as measures by the state's mathematics assessment.
- The percentage of students in grade 6 scoring meets or exceeds in science will increase to 52.1% as measured by the state's science assessment.

RSAE High School Performance Goals by 2025-2026

- The percentage of 9th-12th grade students attaining careerreadiness prior to (on time) graduation will increase to 70% as measured by the SC high school report card.
- The percentage of students scoring 70 or better on the English EOC assessment will increase to 67.2%.
- The percentage of students scoring 70 or better on the Algebra 1 EOC assessment will increase to 31.7%.
- The percentage of students scoring 70 or better on the Biology EOC assessment will increase to 44.8%.
- The percentage of students scoring 70 or better on the US History and Constitution EOC assessment will increase to 62.7%.
