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## Performance DATA for 2011-12

2011-12 State End of Course Test Results: (EOC's)

Percent of AAST 2011-12 seniors successfully completing at least one Advanced Placement or college credit course-56.7\%

School-wide Literacy Writing Goal-80\% of students will increase at least one level in writing based on the SAT writing rubric over the course of the school year. Post-test results: 69\% met the goal At the beginning of the year, only $12 \%$ of students scored a $4,5,6$ using the SAT rubric. By the end of the year, $67 \%$ scored a 4,5 , or 6 .

National Healthcare Assessment—Pre-med seniors are required to take this national exam. AAST pass rate $=83 \%$ compared to state pass rate (58\%) and national pass rate (55\%).
