Student Achievement

Our 1st through 5th grade students take Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments in Reading and Math three times a year, once in the fall, winter and spring. The MAP assessment results are used to identify students' strengths and needs. We look for growth from spring to spring. This year, with the addition of a Title I Math Coach and Title I Interventionist, our MAP math achievement results increased.

Mount Holly Elementary showed improvement on the SC READY assessment that our 3rd – 5th graders take each May. Along with outstanding instruction from our teachers, the additional support from our academic interventionist, tutors, literacy coach and reading buddies have all played a role in the academic growth at Mount Holly.
