The purpose of the Report to the Parents is to give an update on the performance and progress being made toward our improvement goals. In this report, we have provided brief goals, programs, activities, awards, and recognitions for students and teachers.

NOTABLE ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS

- Ninety-seven percent of identified struggling readers in grades 3-6 showed gains while thirty-three percent moved to or above grade level based on Fountas and Pinnel end of the year data.
- Eighty percent of identified struggling readers increased their Measures of Academic Progress score from fall to spring.
- One hundred percent of struggling readers showed significant growth on the Failure Free Reading Program for the 2016-2017 school year.
- Students in grades 1-6 increased their mastery from 30.35% from the beginning of the year to 67.03% at the end of the year on Fountas and Pinnel Assessments.

Goal 1:

For Grades K-6, increase the number of students by 70% that score mastery in reading by the end of the 2016-2017 school year as measured by Fountas and Pinnell.

Goal 2:

Increase communication among families using the school's website, school messenger, social media, and emails to distribute information.
