$\diamond$ By June 2014, the percentage of students who score met and exemplary in English Language Arts, as measured by PASS, will increase from $44.4 \%$ in $\mathbf{2 0 1 3}$ to $\mathbf{7 0 \%}$ in 2014 .
$\diamond$ By June 2014, the percentage of students who score met and exemplary in Mathematies will increase from $\mathbf{4 7 . 7 \%}$ in $\mathbf{2 0 1 3}$ to $\mathbf{7 5 \%}$ in 2014.
$\diamond$ By June 2014, the percentage of students who score met and exemplary in Social Studies, as measured by PASS, will increase from $46.5 \%$ to $60 \%$ in 2014 .
$\diamond \quad$ The percentage of students who score met and exemplary in Science, as measured by PASS, will increase from $46.5 \%$ in 2013 to $50 \%$ in 2014.
