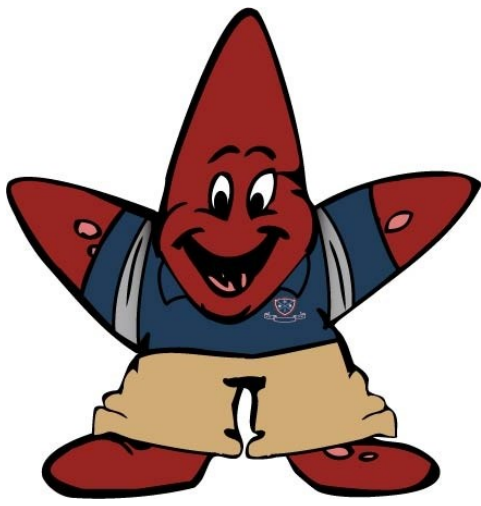

## OUR MISSION

## Points of Pride

- Raised \$3000 for the American Heart Association through "Jump Rope for Heart" program, which teaches children about the importance of heart health.
- Students produced WBRE Eyewitness News, created with green screen technology and HD video, delivered live daily.
- Early Childhood "Kids Club" outreach program brings families in for fun and learning with their young children.
- Backpack Buddies program, a hunger-prevention initiative between Broad River, The Lowcountry Food Bank, and their suppliers provides weekend nutrition to approximately 100 students each week.
- TAP Achievement Score of 5—indicates significantly above-average growth in student achievement scores on the South Carolina End of Year test (Palmetto Assessment of State Standards) for 2013-14.
- Federal AYP met in 2013-14 with a B rating.
- USDA Healthy Schools Award Recipient, which allowed the school to offer a more health-conscious menu and a fresh salad bar daily.
- Full-time Military Family Life Counselor provided by the Department of Defense to work with military dependent students as they transition to and from our school.
- Beaufort-Jasper-Hampton Comprehensive Health Services maintains a clinic on campus, open several days per week, with a full-time nurse practitioner and dental services for students, their families, and the greater community.

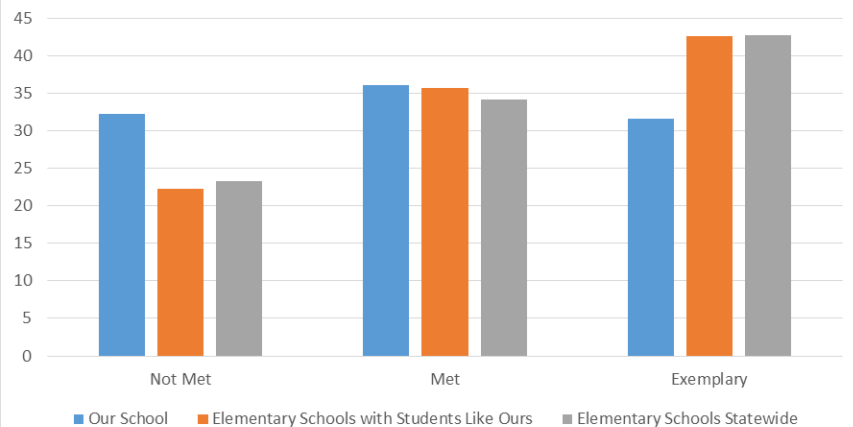
## ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

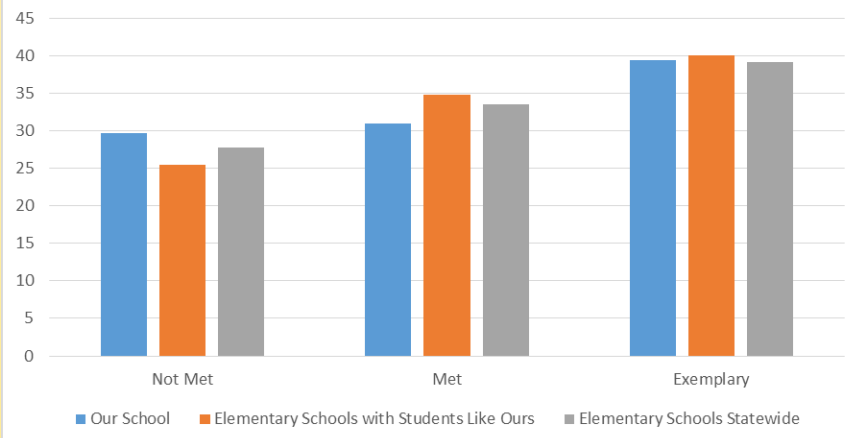
## MAP Percentage of Students Mathematics on Grade Level
