Points of Pride

- Implementation of a "house-system" called Reefs that promotes staff to student mentoring, fosters teamwork and collaboration amongst students and teaches character education and soft-skills
- Students produced WBRE Eyewitness News, created with green screen technology and HD video, delivered live daily.
- Backpack Buddies program, a hunger-prevention initiative between Broad River, The Lowcountry Food Bank, and their suppliers provides weekend nutrition to approximately 100 students each week.

- Federal AYP met in 2015-2016 with a B rating.
