FINE ARTS



Cane Bay continued to live up to its reputation of excellence. Band, Drama, Chorus and Orchestra were all invited to perform for Conferences, Clubs or other Organizations due to their outstanding resumes. Cane Bay Performing Arts continued their dominance: All-County - 51 students, All-Region -24 students, All State – 28 students. In their various State Concert Assessments, they compiled 8 Superior Ratings. Visual Arts won 15 awards in various competitions including ten 1st, four 2nd, and one 3rd place awards. Included in these awards were; Judges Award, Best in Show, Exchange Club Award, Gold Key Winner, and \$3200 in scholarships. For Choir the tradition of the Madrigal Dinners lived on and was enhanced by a performance at the National Cathedral. Cane Bay Drama Company presented multiple productions leading to "Hair Spray" which was attended by over 2300 people. They were also named the "Best of Berkeley County" for the 3rd straight year.

Cane Bay Athletics placed 4 athletes on their respective North/South All-Star Teams and 1 athlete was selected for the Shrine Bowl. Football had another great season and advanced to the 2nd round of playoffs once again. Wrestling took over from there, winning Region 8-4A for the second straight year and finishing 4th in the State. They also had a State Champion at the 132lb. weight class and Coach Wash was selected as the North/South Coach. During this time Cobra Cheerleaders were adding trophies to the case as well with their 4th consecutive Region Championship and placed 3rd in the State. Both Baseball and Boys Soccer were named Region Champions this year. Overall Cane Bay Athletics took a solid step forward with multiple playoff appearances and the majority of teams improving upon records from the previous season.


