CAMBRIDGE INTERNATIONAL PROGRAM

Aiken High School is the 1st Cambridge International Assessments Program in the state of South Carolina. AHS students have joined a global community of learners from over 10,000 schools in over 160 countries. A Cambridge education prepares students for life, helping them develop an informed curiosity and a lasting passion for learning. Students have the opportunity to earn a Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE) diploma. All SC public colleges and universities accept passing scores on AICE examinations for college credit.

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

Aiken High School has a varied and challenging curriculum. College Prep and Honors courses are available in the core curriculum areas. Advanced Placement and Cambridge AICE courses are offered in the following subject areas. Advanced Placement: Biology, Calculus AB, Computer Science A, English Lang/Comp, English Lit/Comp, Psychology, Spanish Lang, Statistics, Art Studio Drawing, US History. Cambridge AICE: English General Paper, English Language, Environmental Management, Global Perspectives & Research. Successful completion of Advanced Placement and Cambridge AICE courses and the required exams allows students to receive college credit. Students also have opportunities to earn additional high school credits through the SC Virtual School Program, Aiken County Virtual School Pro-gram, and Edmentum learning.
