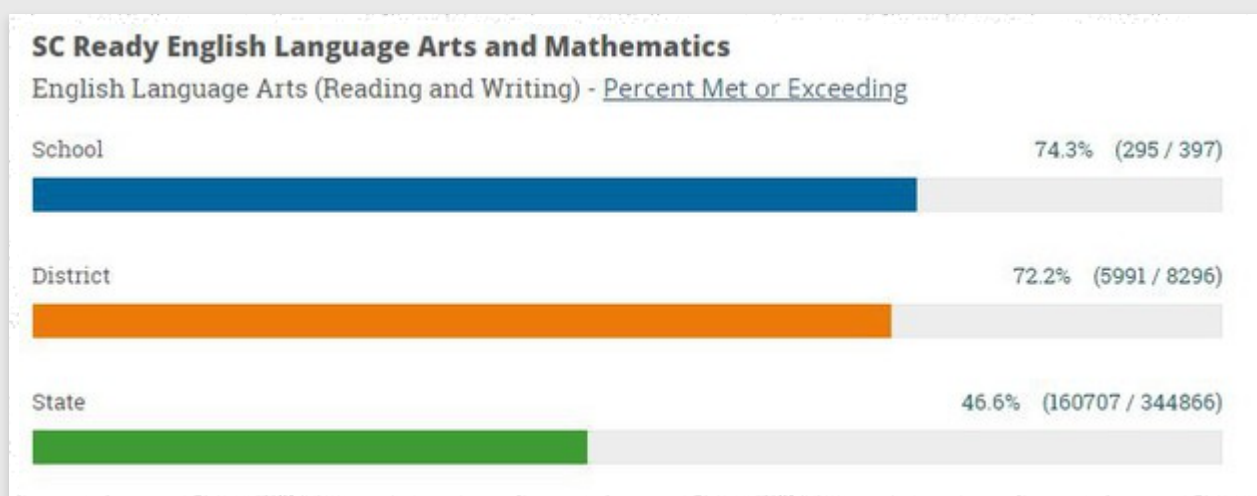

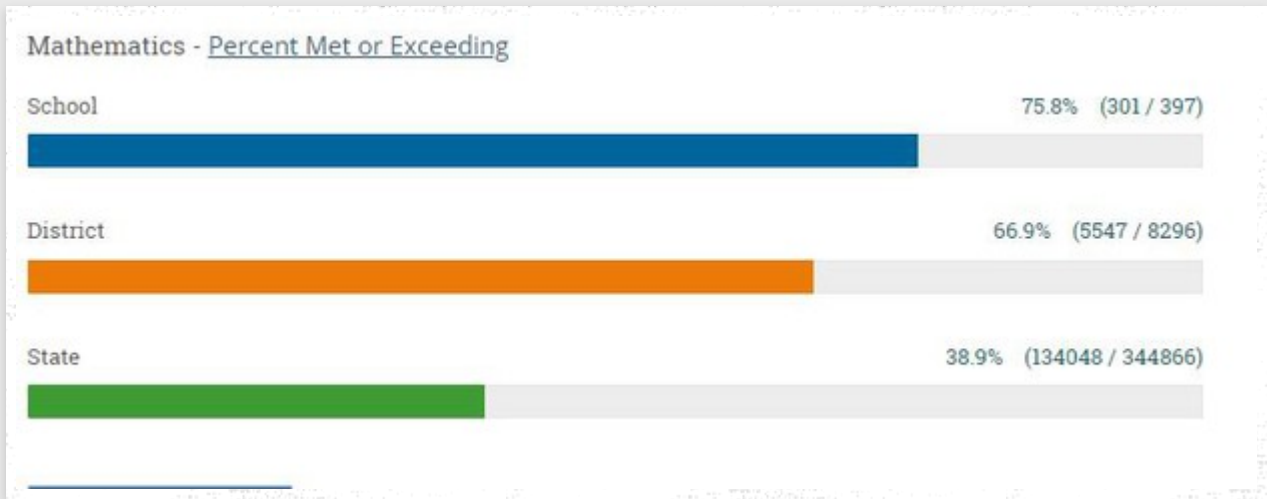

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Due to the generosity of our school community, we were able to assist 37 families with gifts for the holidays. The school was also able to provide 23 Thanksgiving meals for families in need.
- Our school was able to raise \$76,000.00 in Boosterthon money to support educational initiatives and facility upgrades.
- Over 115 students participated in the York County Literacy Picnic in May of 2022.
- Pleasant Knoll hosted several community events. The community picnic engaged students and parents in games and activities. Over 800 people participated in the community picnic.

- Pleasant Knoll had over \$26,000.00 in sales during our fall and spring scholastic book fair.
- Pleasant Knoll continues to have a high teacher retention rate. This year, over 96% of our faculty returned and it is anticipated that over 98% will return for the 22-23 school year.
