#### ACHIEVEMENT HIGHLIGHTS

- RCES Overall Rating increased from Good to Excellent.
- The percentage of students scoring exceeds or meets on SC Ready math and reading assessment increased 4 percentage points.
- RCES has a greater percentage of students meeting or exceeding gradelevel expectations in reading and math compared to schools in the state.
- The percentage of students surpassing grade-level expectations in math is nearly 20% higher than the statewide average, and in reading, it is also close to 20% higher than schools statewide.

### PROFESSIONAL LEARNING

- LETRS is a professional learning course for instructors of reading, spelling, and related language skills. It provides educators with in-depth knowledge and tools that they can use with any reading program.
