The Palmetto Assessment of the State Standards (PASS) is a summative, high-stake test given to all 3-8 graders in South Carolina. It measures student achievement in the four content areas, including writing. These scores are representative of the 2012-13 school year, as the 2014 PASS has not been administered as of this publication.
