## School Community Achievements/Accomplishments

- 8th grade girls basketball team were the runners-up in the Peachtree Tournament Championship
- Antonio Scott had the highest ELA PSAT score in D2
- 11 perfect scores on the Algebra I EOC
- 7 students participated in the Spartanburg Sings
- We put on our first drama production, *Rapunzel*
- 12 6th graders, 4 7th graders, and 6 8th graders participated in our Hope Squad Campaign
- A team of students from our investing club finished 9th in the nation out of more than 1,700 teams competing in SIFMA's annual stock market challenge.

## Performance Results

### Strengths

- School percentages for Meets plus Exceeds in English, Science, and Social Studies were higher than the state average
- 8th grade ELA had 64.3% score Meets or Exceeds
- 8th grade Math had 41.9% of students score Meets or Exceeds
- 96% of students passed the Algebra 1 EOC

### Performance Goals

- Increase the number of students who pass the state test by 1% in each subject area.
- Maintain 100% students passing the Algebra 1.
- Increase the number of perfect scores 1% on the Algebra 1 and English 1 EOC.
- Increase growth in our lowest performing students by 1%.
- Increase the number of Junior Scholars by 10%.
- Further enhance the digital transformation by continuing to increase meaningful integration during our instructional practice.
