### Strengths

#### 2018 scores

- School percentages for Meets plus Exceeds in all content areas were higher than the state
- 98.9% of all students showed growth on the SC Ready state assessment
- 77% of the students in 7th grade scored Met plus Exemplary on the SS PASS test
- 100% of the students passed the English 1 and Algebra 1 EOC

### Performance Goals
