Performance Results

Strengths

- School percentages for Meets plus Exceeds in English, Science, and Social Studies were higher than the state
- 7th grade ELA had 54% score Meets or Exceeds
- 8th grade Math had 43% of students score Meets or Exceeds
- 100% of students passed the Algebra 1 EOC

Performance Goals

- Increase the number of students who pass the state test by 1% in each subject area.
- Maintain 100% students passing the Algebra 1 and English 1 EOC.
- Increase the number of perfect scores 1% on the Algebra 1 and English 1 EOC.
- Increase growth in our lowest performing students by 1%.
- Increase the number of Junior Scholars by 50%.
