cultivate home-school relations, we have hosted many engaging activities for parents

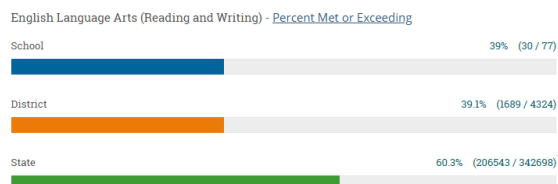
and students. Parents were invited to learn and explore our teaching and learning environment, learn more about the SC Standards for various content areas, student achievement, and engage in parent/student data chats.

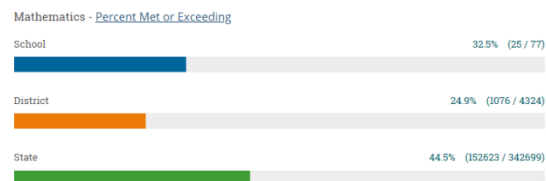


HKTE Achievement Data
