- Many activities such as PTO sponsored events, Starbase, Marine Corps Band performance, Spring Cookout, Read Across America, , Kids’ Hope mentors, MOES Field Day, Kids Club, Family Focus Nights, Vanderbilt University Alternative Spring Break, etc., actively engage our community and stakeholders.
- ☑ SIC continues to find ways in which to involve all parents in the life of the school.

**Goal #4: Provide resources for appropriate learning environments.**

- ☑ SIC assisted with the writing of the school-based budget used to purchase materials to support the learning environment and to provide professional development opportunities for staff to support the learning environment.
- ☑ SIC assisted in the writing of the Title I Budget and Title I Focus Plan, which allowed for additional funds for school support.
