The SC Department of Education released Value Added Student Growth data for the 2015-2016 school year. This data point is measured on a scale of 1 to 5 with 3 being proficient. The scale is defined by the state as follows:

- Level 5: Most Effective
- Level 4: Above Average Effectiveness
- Level 3: Average Effectiveness
- Level 2: Approaching Average Effectiveness
- Level 1: Least Effective

CRE received a score of a **5** for the 2015-2016 school year!

By the end of the 2018-2019 school year, 70% of students in grades 3-5 will score ready or above on the state assessment with every student making one year's growth.



Math
