Measure of Academic Performance or MAP Tests are computerized adaptive tests used to determine students' achievement level. Students are tested in *Mathematics* and *Reading* during the Fall and Spring to measure the amount of growth throughout the year.



Glenview's Junior Scholars:

Students who scored 550 or higher on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing <u>or</u> 530 or higher on the Math portion of the <u>PSAT/NMSQT as an 8th grader</u>; <u>or</u> students who participated in Duke University's Talent Identification Program (TIP) during their seventh-grade year, who met the eligibility requirements as outlined by that program (criteria listed above) are identified as South Carolina Junior Scholars.
