Measure of Academic Performance or MAP Tests are computerized adaptive tests used to determine students' achievement level. Students are tested in **Mathematics** and **Reading** during the Fall and Spring to measure the amount of growth throughout the year.



Glenview's Junior Scholars:

Students who scored 550 or higher on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing or 530 or higher on the Math portion of the **PSAT/NMSQT as an 8th grader**; or students who participated in Duke University's Talent Identification Program (TIP) during their seventh-grade year, who met the eligibility requirements as outlined by that program (criteria listed above) are identified as South Carolina Junior Scholars.

The purpose of the program is to identify students and provide opportunities that will facilitate their intellectual growth, broaden their individual interests, and promote their scholastic achievement.
