Student ambassadors were voted in by their peers to represent the student body in a leadership role to ensure learning, safety, and joy were at the center of all that we do.

2021-2022 YEAR IN REVIEW

The 2021-2022 school year began with hopes of a more traditional year, however, contact tracing, quarantines, and absences continued to provide challenges throughout the first semester. The "interrupted learning" over the past two years attributed to an increased focus on intentional data tracking and differentiated instruction to ensure all students were given the opportunity to reach their potential. The School Improvement Council unanimously supported maintaining the goal to facilitate academic growth for all students during this school year. Action steps toward this goal included weekly data chats with teachers, continued use of interventionist and tutors to work with students in small groups and monitor student progress, and professional development for teachers in content specific curriculum and social emotional skills.

The second goal of the School Improvement Council was to increase community support of Port Royal Elementary School. Our first bookfair in November was wildly successful and through community donations we were able to make sure every student went home with a book of their choice. In addition, we were able to add a parent who is a registered dietician in our local community to our wellness committee. Our three family engagement night events; STEM, literacy, and math, brought families back to the school to celebrate academics. In addition, we were able to work with the local police department and the Port Royal Town Hall to decrease the speed limit within the block of the school making the students' arrival and dismissal safer.

After receiving feedback from all stakeholders: staff, students, parents, and community members; the School Improvement Council approved a new vision and mission for Port Royal Elementary School on Thursday, March 17, 2022.
