## Student Achievement

### SC READY

The South Carolina College-and Career Ready Assessments (SC READY) are statewide assessments in English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics that will meet all of the requirements of Acts 155 and 200, the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA). The charts below compare Lucy T. Davis with other schools in F1S and elementary schools statewide. \*Below are the percentages of students Meets & Exceeds.
