MGMS BY THE NUMBERS

64.3% of students are White, 12% Black or African American, 11.2% Asian, 7.3% Hispanic/Latino, and 5.2% of students are two or more races.

Currently, 11% of students receive special education services, and 34.7% of students are identified as students in poverty.

WORK PLAN GOALS

ELA K-8 (growth): The percentage of students meeting or exceeding stretch growth targets on i-Ready Reading will improve by 3 percentage points. **29.3% → 33% – Met**

Math K-8 (growth): The percentage of students meeting or exceeding stretch growth targets on i-Ready Mathematics will improve by 4 percentage points **28.7% → 28.8% – Not Met**
