In our eighth year:

- ✚ Our staff of 8 instructors served over 70 students in grades 9-12 representing many ethnicities and socio-economic backgrounds.
- ✚ Over the course of 9 years, 282 students have graduated AVCS. This year we have 14 students who will graduate this June.
- ✚ We offered opportunities for college counseling through IGP meetings, our career and college readiness class and two college visits to three different campuses.
- ✚ We conducted one graduation ceremony with 20 graduating in June.

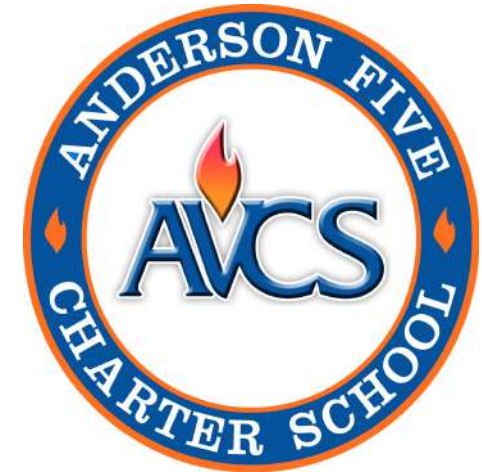
