

School Achievements

In our fourth year:

- ✚ We used our staff of 8 people to serve over 100 students in grades 8-12 representing many ethnicities and socio-economic backgrounds.
- ✚ We have offered opportunities for college counseling through IGP meetings, our career and college readiness class and 2 college visits to 4 different campuses.
- ✚ We continued our partnership with Adult Ed to help 17-20 year old students get a second chance at earning a diploma. This program currently serves over 50 students.
- ✚ We conducted 2 graduation ceremonies with 36 graduating in June and 4 in August.
- ✚ Our graduates include:
 - 5 licensed cosmetologists
 - 3 nursing majors
 - 1 National Guardsperson
 - 1 mechatronics major

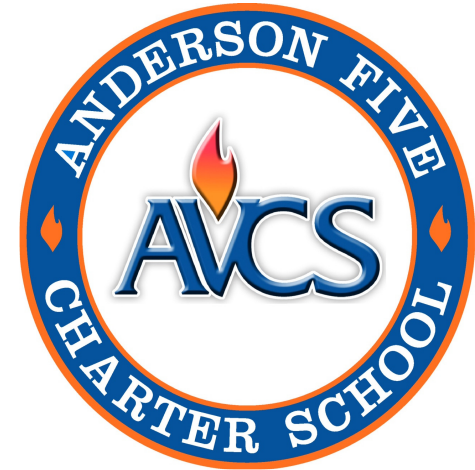
