## Student Achievement

Engagement Technology Literacy Results

- CBM earned **at or above the state and district average** in all content areas on 2018 State Assessments.
- Second year of our LiveSchool implementation. With a 1:3 ratio for bonuses and demerits, CBM students have earned **3.4 million points for positive behaviors and have applied 1.1 million points towards rewards**. *Students continue to earn over 95% of all available Live School points every day!*
- **Imagine Math** a personalized learning tool is used in all math classes grades 5-8 for mathematics. *Over 85% of classes are at or over 70% achievement in Imagine Math.*
- **Common Sense Media** certification for the **third year in a row** with **100% Student/Staff completion of Common Sense Media training.**
- **Student Selected Reading (SSR)** is a school-wide, weekly practice support and encourages a culture of literacy in grades 5-8.



## School Climate

Safety Diversity Extracurricular Activities Communication

- Over 45 **active student led clubs** - *every child either participates in or leads one club each year!*
- **Veteran's Day** celebration held with over 100 veterans honored.
- **Classroom guidance** and **Cobra Confidential** successfully support positive peer relationships, problem solving, and respect for diversity among students.
- Berkeley County Mental Health counselor made available for students with **therapeutic counseling** needs.
- **10 students** take part in mentoring with community partner, Church of Cane Bay.
- **15 Advisory groups** meet weekly to support student relationship
- **Transition support events** for all rising 5th and 6th grade students and exiting 8th grade students.
- **Cafeteria, custodial, and clerical teams** consistently earn excellent ratings and praise from families, students, and district staff for their high quality work. *We are fortunate to have such incredible support teams in place!*
