### STUDENT WINS FOR THE YEAR!

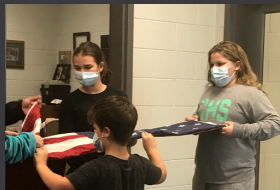
We wanted to hear from our students about what they felt were "wins" for the year. Here is a summary of what we found!

51% of our students were able to identify an academic win.

19% of our students were able to prioritize a mental/physical health win.

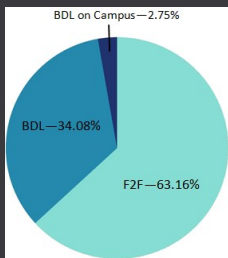
17% identified a friendship or other relationship win.

9% identified a win regarding extra-curricular activities.



### WE HAVE THE MEETS!

Our students and staff have been conducting a LOT of Google Meets this year. As of March 30th, our teachers have held approximately 23,000 separate Google Meets.



### ACADEMIC WINS

Throughout this school year, our Cobras have shown amazing perseverance. 82% of our students are passing all FOUR core content areas.

As a school this year, our students were able to raise their Reading and Math Inventories. In the Math Inventory, our students' average score went up by 68 points by Winter 2021!

We also had 18 students qualify as Junior Scholars based on their PSAT scores!



### DIFFERENT PATHWAYS FOR DIFFERENT STUDENTS

Our students have been learning to be successful from different pathways this school year.

63.16% of our students are learning face-to-face. 34.08% are blended learners and 2.75% of our students are BDL on campus



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### TO HIGH SCHOOL (CREDITS) AND BEYOND!

Cobras have always strived to do their best and to excel. For our 7th and 8th graders, that means taking the opportunity to earn high school credit.

54% of our 7th and 8th graders are taking at least 1 credit course!

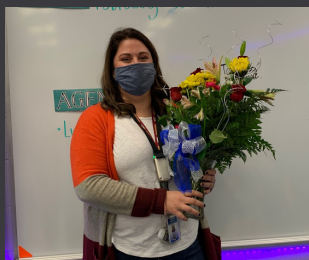
### TEACHER WINS!

In spite of all the challenges of instruction during COVID, our teachers also identified strong wins for the year. The vast majority of our teacher wins fell into the following categories.

1. Still being able to build successful relationships with students.
2. Feeling as though they had a supportive team to help them.
3. Being proud of our students for following our safety protocols, including mask-wearing.
4. Being able to learn new tech tips and tricks to make our students successful!
5. Learning to multitask during this very different year.

### MULTITASKING MAESTROS

At the beginning of the school year, 95% of our teachers were working in hybrid classrooms. As of January, we have 51 teachers who are face-to-face, 15 who are hybrid, and 14 who are all "blended distance."



### INTRODUCING MOBYMAX

Our students have worked incredibly hard at sharpening their skills with MobyMax once it was introduced in February. As of mid-March, our students have spent over 357,000 minutes on the program.
