Student Achievement

Engagement Technology Literacy Results

- CBM earned at or above the state and district average in all content areas on 2019 State Assessments.
- Third year of our LiveSchool implementation with a 1:2 ratio for bonuses and demerits, CBM students have earned **4.9 million points for positive behaviors and have applied 1.1 million points towards rewards**. Students continue to earn over 95% of all available Live School points every day!
- <u>Imagine Math</u> a personalized learning tool is used in all math classes grades 5-8 for mathematics. Over 85% of classes are at or over 70% achievement in Imagine Math.
- Common Sense Media certification for the fourth year in a row with 100% Student/Staff completion of <u>Common Sense Media</u> training.
- CBM improved its overall report card rating from a 29 (Below Average) to a 50 (Good).

- 10 students take part in mentoring with community partner, Church of Cane Bay.
- 8 students take part in mentoring with community partner, Charleston Southern University's Football Team
- Over 120 Northwoods church members volunteered their time with the day of caring. The volunteers assisted with cleaning classroom desks, lockers and washing all walls and restrooms.
