


Grade 3-5 ELA - 46.4% students scored Meets or Exceeds **Grade 3-5 Math -** 43.4% students scored Meets or Exceeds

SC Ready Scores:


Grade 6-8 ELA - 43.2% students scored Exceeds or Meets **Grade 6-8 Math** – 22.6% students scored Exceeds or Meets
